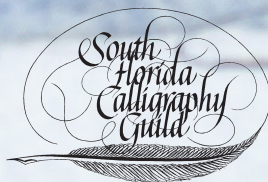

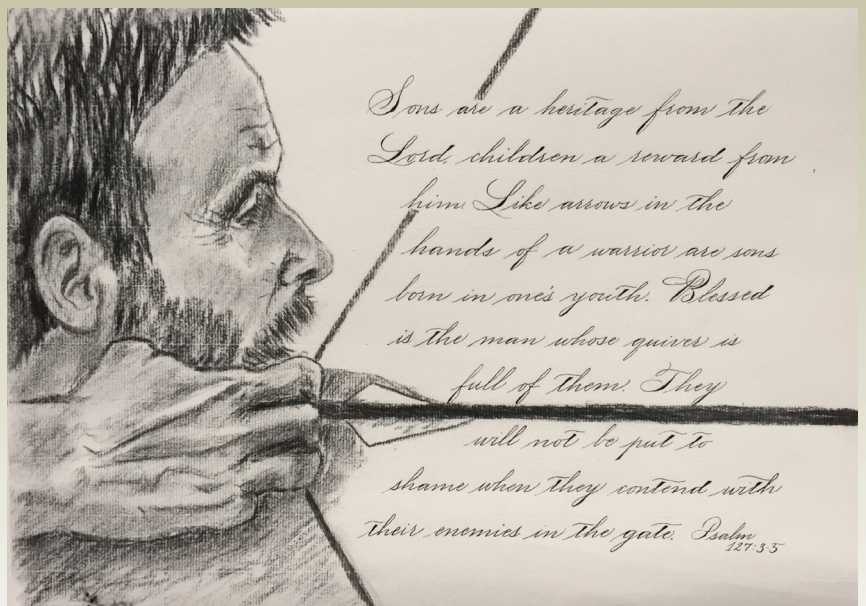

THE *artist* BEHIND THE COVER

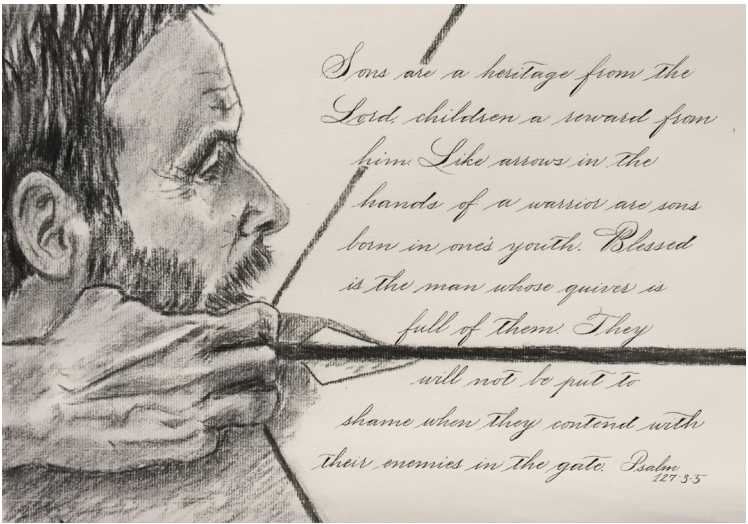

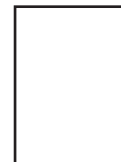
